

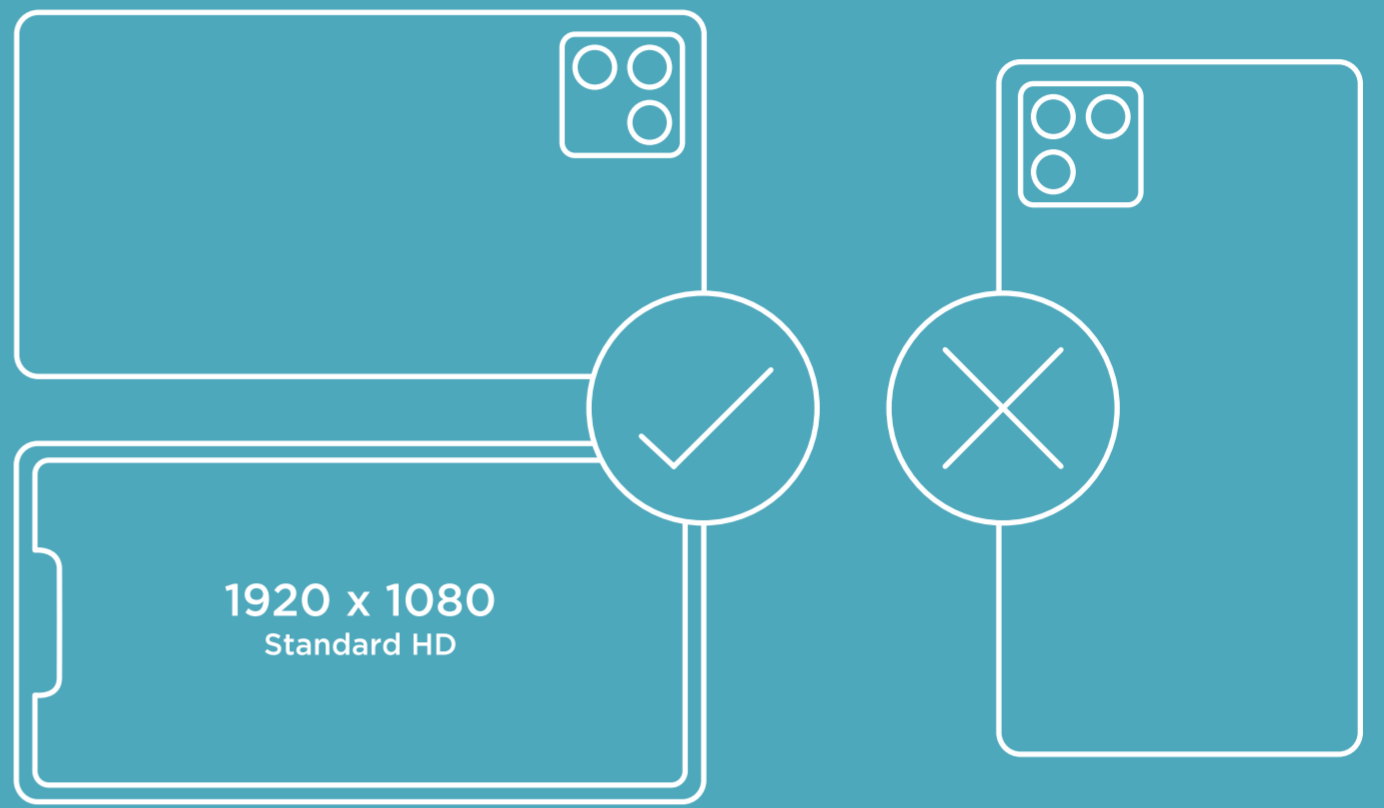


5 Things you should know when filming an interview on your phone.

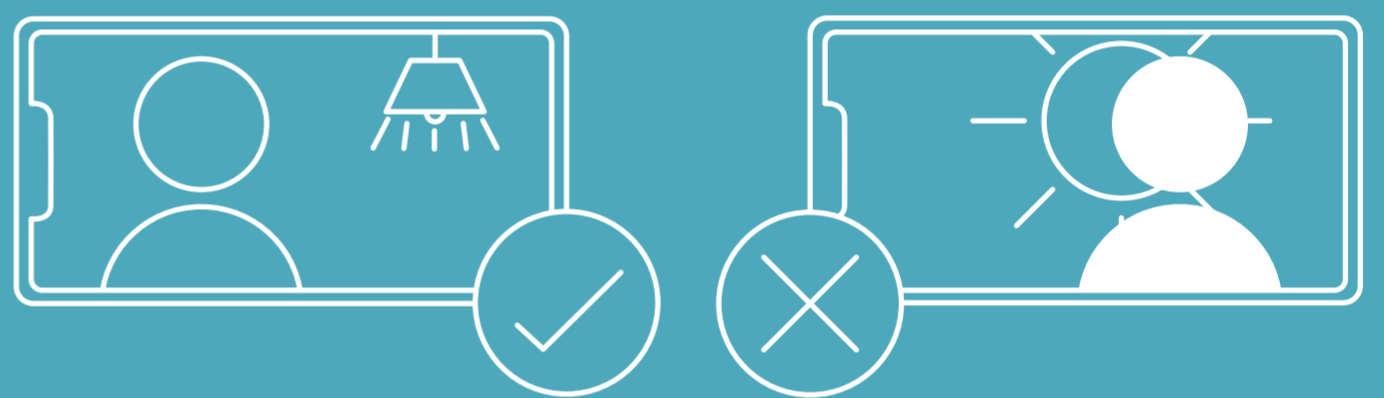
1. Set up your phone

- Use landscape mode
- Set resolution to 1920x1080 pixels
- Get this right for clear, easy to edit footage



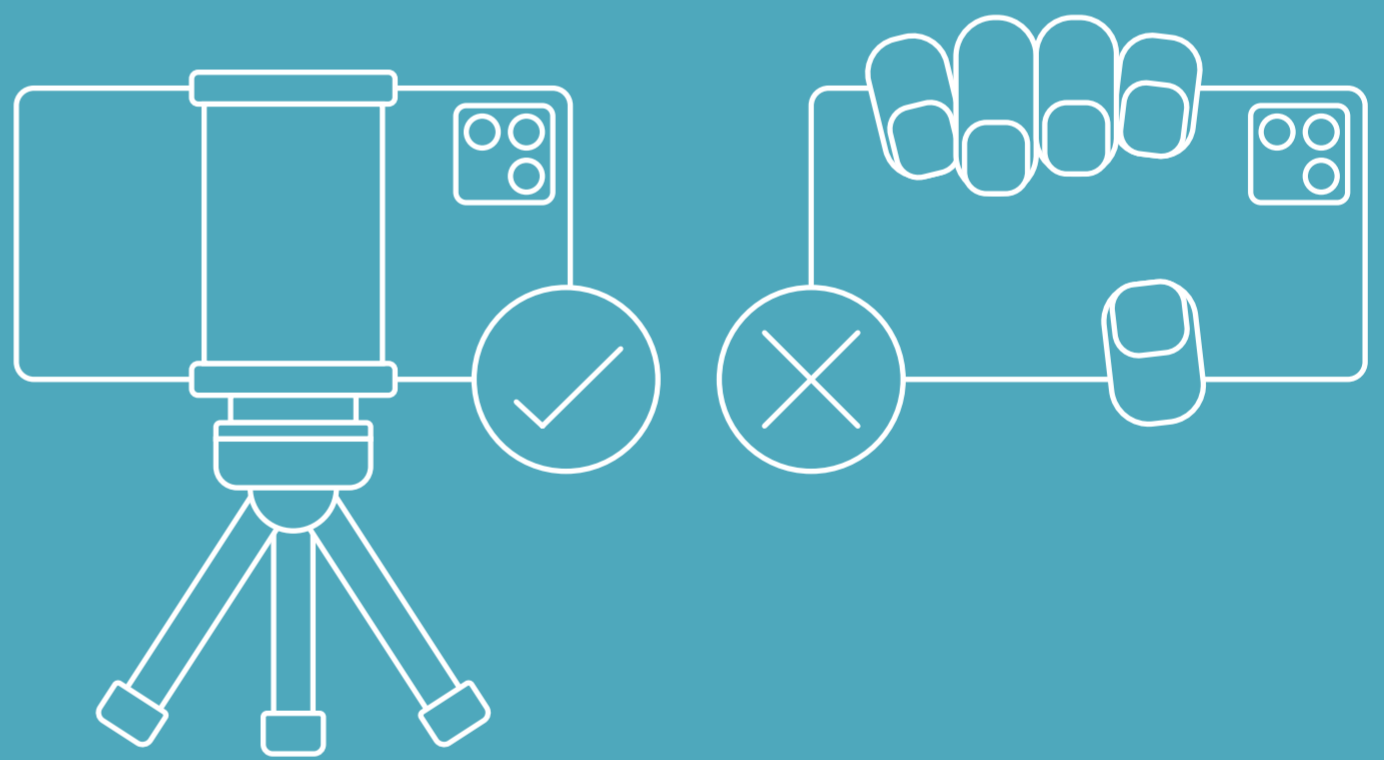
2. Select the right location

- Film in a well lit room
- Don't point the camera at direct sunlight
- Don't film outside



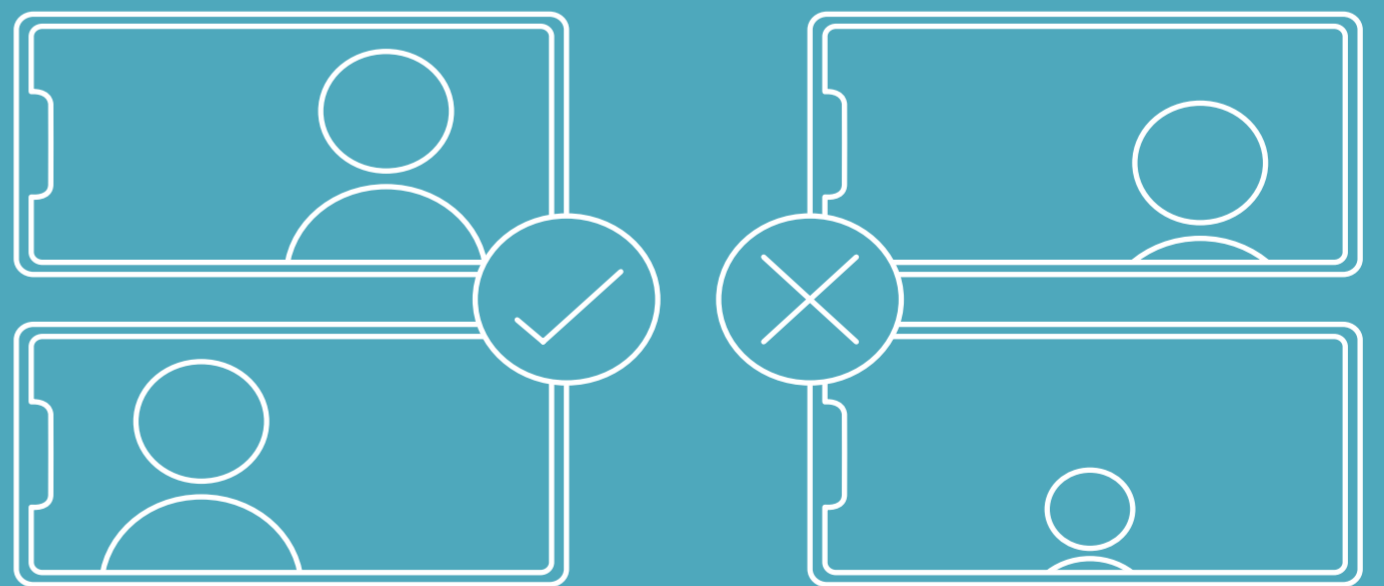
3. Use a tripod

- Cheap and easy to use
- Banish shaking
- Perfect Framing



4. Frame the shot

- Subject close to the camera, slightly off centre
- Interview: Eyeline opposite to where they're sitting
- Direct message: Eyeline directly into the camera



5. Audio

- For best results use a microphone
- Film in a quiet location - film indoors
- Keep camera close to subject
